

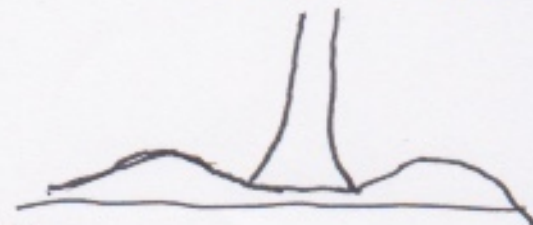
## Recommended Street Trees for Tree Lawns

| 7. <i>Quercus macrocarpa</i>                         | bur oak   |
| 8. <i>Quercus alba</i>                               | white oak   |
| 9. <i>Quercus shumardii</i>                          | Shumard oak   |
| 10. <i>Quercus muehlenbergii</i>                     | chinkapin oak/chestnut oak                          |
| 11. <i>Quercus bicolor</i>                           | swamp white oak                                     |
| 12. <i>Aesculus x arnoldiana</i> 'Autumn Splendor'   | autumn splendor horsechestnut                       |
| 13. <i>Aesculus x carnea</i> 'Fort McNair'           | Fort McNair Horsechestnut                           |
| 14. <i>Acer miyabei</i> Morton 'State Street'        | state street miyabe maple                           |

| 20. <i>Ostrya virginiana</i>                         | eastern hop hornbeam                                |

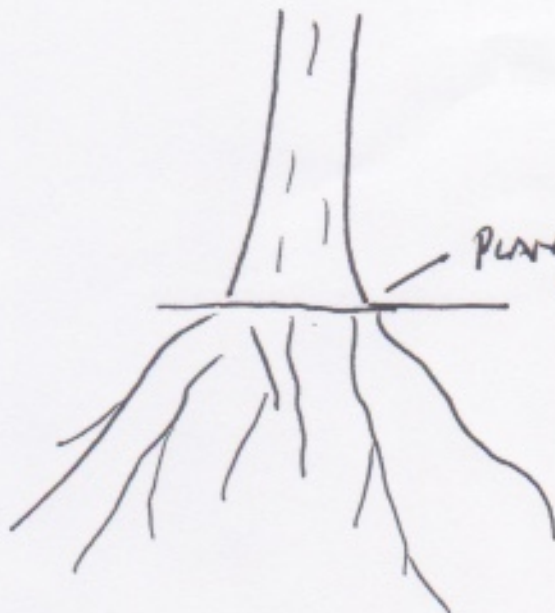
